Viewing your Virtual Tour:

You can view your virtual tour on the Virtual Tours Photography website at:

http://virtours.co.za/virtual-tours/St_Andrews/index.html

You can also install the included Panotour Viewer on your computer. See the right-hand panel.

Publishing your Virtual Tour to your webserver:

A virtual tour is not a simple image or file, it is a group of files that have to be hosted on a server.

A minimum knowledge of web publishing is required. However, launching a virtual from your website is quite simple when all the files have been uploaded, just launch the "index.html" file from your browser.

- **Uploading the tour**

Uploading the tour is simple, you need a web server. Then, all you need to do is place the tour and all of its contents on your server.

- **Accessing the tour**

Now that you've uploaded the tour to your server, all you need to do is get the public link for the tour's "index.html" file. That's it!

You don't need an internet connection to show your virtual tour to your customers and friends. This can be very useful for sales people when presenting to potential clients.

Once the software is installed, launch Panotour Viewer and load the "index.pvt" file

This is your whole virtual tour. All the required files are contained in the indexdata folder. Both the index.html file and the indexdata folder must be uploaded to your server and placed in a virtual tour folder (sub-directory). (You can name this directory anything you like). This folder or directory must be created within the public.html directory.
